Teacher Featured	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Tell and show how a UCPS teacher (current, former or retired) has made a difference in your life or even changed your life. We define “teacher” as someone who spends the majority of their day with students. (classroom teacher, assistant teacher, specials teacher, coach, speech therapist, school counselor, etc.) ➤ Only one teacher may be featured in your video. ➤ You must include at least one photo of your featured teacher in your video. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Photo of you and/or other students with the teacher. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Video of the teacher from school events, classroom lectures, and/or other activities etc. ➤ Video of you. (Yes, sometimes videos are submitted and we never see the student talking to the camera at all! 😊)
Creativity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The video must be your original student work. Check out our YouTube page for inspiration from other years. Click on the Teacher Tribute playlist. ➤ Your voice must be narrating your video, and you must also be featured in at least one photo. We are looking for more than just a “Powerpoint with photos.” ➤ Do not just sit and read into the camera for two minutes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Make us laugh, cry, or smile. Any humor needs to be clean and reflect the teacher in the most positive way. ➤ Background music. (Check copyrights since we post online and we don’t want your video blocked) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Do some research! Watch a few of the past recipient videos and do something totally out of the box, original, and that says “you.”
Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Two minute maximum video length and no less than one minute. Your video must be less than 5000 Kilobytes in order to be uploaded to Reviewr.com ➤ Need assistance? Check out the Video Making Tips on our website for multiple resources to help you. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Subtitles. Your video may be viewed in all sorts of settings and we want the audience to hear all the great things you have to say about your teacher. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Smooth transitions and a well-defined ending. Just like a well-written story, your video needs to have a beginning, middle and ending. No mid-sentence cut offs!
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>Your video must include the phrase "This is my Teacher Tribute for the Dr. Ed Davis College Scholarship" with a screen shot of our logo available for download.</u> You can include this phrase and logo at the beginning or the end. Once submitted, your video becomes property of the Education Foundation and we will use it to post to social media and elsewhere. ➤ <u>Please only share what you are ok with being made public.</u>
